RESPONDING to Families' Needs

- **Temporary Locations:** Expanded services in Durham, Chico, Magalia and Oroville for kids that have been displaced.
- Case Management: Building relationships with our families to triage and help meet immediate needs, and connect them with local resources.
- **Creating Stability:** Helping families settle into their new life while we focus on ensuring our youth have what they need to succeed.



REBUILDING Programs & Services

- New Sites: 3 Clubs in Paradise & Magalia and 1 Club expansion in Chico.
- Transportation: Increased access from schools to Clubs and field trips.
- **Staff Training:** Trauma responsive care, resiliency skill building, mental health first aid, positive youth development and programming practices.
- Therapeutic Programming: Helping youth positively cope and work through their losses, anger, trauma, triggers and everyday challenges.



COMMITMENT to Long-Term Healing

- **Restoring Hope:** Consistent, predictable year-round programs and mentoring with trauma trained staff and onsite mental health services.
- **Increasing Collaborations:** Partnering with the Camp Fire Long-Term Recovery Group to return our families to their pre-fire housing status.
- **New Beginnings**: Focusing on our future looking for long-term solutions and benefits that will build us back better and stronger.
