SUMMER CAMPS

Camp Jamoa is a full service summer day camp that serves youth (1st-8th grade). Our camp program is open Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 6:00pm. Our Camp is the most affordable summer program and provides some of the most inclusive and extensive services which include weekly local field trips and meals.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP & FEES

Camp is CURRENTLY for enrolled members only

Camp Jamoa Tuition: \$25 Per Week (8:00am - 5:30pm)
Camp Shirt: \$15 Must be worn on all field trips

PAYMENTS

A <u>non-refundable deposit</u> of \$10 per week is due at the time of registration to secure your child's space for each week of camp. This deposit will be taken out of the total amount due. The deposit guarantees that your child will have a space for the registered week. The remaining balance will be due no later than the Thursday prior to the week that your child is enrolled. Payments are to be made with cash or credit card only.

DROP OFF & PICK UP-UPDATED MAY 2020

Each day, Camp Jamoa will begin at the location you registered. Members must be dropped off and checked in by a parent or guardian. Members will need to be checked in between 8:00am-9:15am and out between 4:30pm-5:30pm all pickup and drop off will be done outside of the building. Also members will have temperatures checked upon arrival and as needed during the day. Members cannot be dropped off or picked up during or on field trip travels. While on field trips, families may pick up their member if they make prior arrangements with the Camp Coordinator with at least 24 hours in advance.

Hello Boys & Girls Club Families,

We hope that you are all safe, healthy, and doing well. Our Club team has missed you and we look forward to a time that we can all be together again. We are especially excited that the Club will be open for Summer Camp!

The Boys and Girls Clubs of the North Valley is committed to safety and health procedures and will be following all safety protocols and mandates put forth by the CDC and County. We want to update you on some changes that we will be making in order to provide your family with the best and safe summer experience.

Safety Modifications:

- Summer Camp (full-day service) will be the **only** service we will be able to offer this summer.
- All staff and youth members will be required to wear a mask while inside Club. *If your child does not have a mask, the Club will provide a mask for them.
- All staff and youth members will have their temperature taken upon arrival and possibly during the day as needed.
- Camp times will be changed to 8:00am to 5:30pm due to staff cleaning processes
- All youth members must be dropped off between 8:00am-9:30am
- All youth members must be picked up between 4:30pm-5:30pm
 - Doctors' appointments and important meetings can be accommodated with at least a 24 hour notice to Camp Coordinator
- · Only staff and youth members will be permitted into the building
- We will be practicing all social distancing protocols

Due to social distance protocols we will be reducing the amount of members who can register for camp to only 50 campers per week per camp. This will be on a first come, first served bases with registration and paid deposit. Club families with year round membership will get priority.
