## Fundraising timeline

We expanded into Glenn County and opened the Boys & Girls Club of Hamilton City in August 2016. We have been successful each year in reaching and even exceeding our program and membership goals. In order to continue to provide our life changing programs at Hamilton Elementary we are in need of five-year commitments to continue to serve more than 200 youth during the school year and provide a full day summer camp throughout the summer.

## What is needed

A variety of private and public resources are needed to sustain our Club in Hamilton City. We are asking our friends, neighbors, local leaders, and businesses to join us in making a commitment to local youth by helping us provide a safe place where they can learn and grow.

## Community fundraising

Our goal is to raise enough pledges to total \$75,000 so we can focus our attention on providing high-quality, high-impact programs for our youth members. All pledge sponsors will be recognized on our website and at an annual event.

## Boys & Girls Clubs of the North Valley (BGCNV) – A Private 501(c)3 Corporation

Our Clubs were founded in 1993 as the Boys & Girls Club of Chico. In 2001 we merged with the Boys & Girls Club of Paradise Ridge to form the Boys & Girls Clubs of the North Valley (BGCNV), which currently operates nine sites in three communities. In Chico we have the Ostrander Clubhouse for kids ages 6 to 10, the Chico Phoenix Club for ages 10-12 and “The Club” for 13-18 year olds. In Paradise, we operate three clubs on school sites (Paradise Ridge Elementary, Paradise Intermediate and Pine Ridge). In 2007 we opened a ground-breaking site in Butte County Juvenile Hall and opened a teen center in the Oroville Southside Community Center. In 2016 we partnered with Hamilton Unified School District to open a Club on their campus. In 2018 we moved the Oroville Teen Center to Las Plumas High School and opened a third location in Chico post-Camp Fire to take in displaced Club families. BGCNV has approximately 2,000 members and serves 750 youth a day.



The Boys & Girls Clubs of the North Valley is a locally run, GuideStar Platinum Participant non-profit that is governed by a board of 40 community leaders. The Boys & Girls Clubs of the North Valley relies on local contributions to raise the additional funds necessary for its successful operations in each community.
